Name of the project: Optimizing change processes for the circular economy

## Abstract of the project:

Most organizations rely on a linear logic of doing business by converting natural resources into waste via production. However, as this traditional business model comes with severe negative impacts on the environment and society, companies have begun to embrace the logic of the circular economy. However, systematic research into how to master this change from a linear to a circular business logic is scarce.

Therefore, the purpose of this PhD dissertation is to integrate research from organizational change management and circular economy, while identifying key success factors and design elements of a suitable change management approach, as well as understanding when and why this approach can be successful. To this end, this dissertation will investigate firm-level organizational change processes from an organizational behavior perspective. Organizational behavior research investigates how individual, team, and organizational factors influence the behavior of individuals and teams. The goal is to advance our scientific understanding of the behavioral aspects of the circular economy and derive evidence-based recommendations for practitioners. To achieve this goal, a set of different methodologies will be used, that is, narrative literature review, comparative case study, and field study.
